Can-Eng Furnaces International Ltd. has secured a contract for a Roller Hearth Iso-Thermal Annealing line for a major American producer of steel automotive impression forgings located in North Carolina. The system will be capable of both Iso-Thermal Annealing and Normalizing consisting of a high temperature furnace operating under EXO atmosphere, a separate low temperature Roller Hearth furnace, automatic bin dump and loading system, integrated tray/basket return system, and Level II Automation technology. Installation of the Equipment will begin in Q2 2024. This is the 4th contract awarded to CAN-ENG in recent years, the previous three were configured as a Mesh Belt Normalizing furnace, Cast Link Belt Normalizing furnace, and a Roller Hearth Iso-Thermal Annealing Furnace.



### \*WALKER INDUSTRIES

Walker Industries (Walker) announced that its Niagara Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) facility has reached final stages of commissioning, making it the largest RNG project in Ontario. The Niagara RNG plant will capture and refine landfill gas into low-carbon RNG, providing enough clean energy for more than 8,750 residential homes while reducing greenhouse gas emissions (GHGs) by 48,000 tonnes over a year. "The project represents our commitment to innovation and sustainability," said Geordie Walker, President and CEO, Walker Industries. "For the past 20 years, we have been harnessing landfill gas into energy and we are excited to provide a consistent source of clean natural gas that can heat homes and support industrial activity for many years to come."



### **NIAGARA RIVER TRADIN**



Niagara River Trading began construction of its new manufacturing facility and warehouse at 6162 Progress Road in the Stanley Avenue Business Park. The new facility will have a total gross floor area of 64,058 sg ft. The new construction and related expansion will support the retention of the company's current 60 jobs and support future hires of 40-50 full-time employees. Niagara River Trading Company is a provider of products to over 2,000 active retail customers in the souvenir and resort industry in Canada and the USA. 2023 sales were projected at \$17 million with an expected increase of over \$20 million by the time the new facility is complete. The company has outgrown their current space at 6199 Don Murie Street.

Christopher Penny, manager of hydrogen products at Atura Power, envisions the forthcoming Niagara Hydrogen Centre as a crucial player in Ontario's shift towards cleaner energy. Despite hydrogen's historical stigma, Penny sees its potential in curbing greenhouse gas emissions, emphasizing its safety and versatility. By utilizing electrolysis to produce hydrogen fuel and oxygen, the facility aims to reduce carbon footprints in power generation and industrial sectors. With support from local leaders and strategic partnerships, Atura Power is poised to advance Ontario's transition to a greener economy, with the facility expected to be operational bv mid-2024.







Niagara Parks has selected Pearle Hospitality to revitalize the historic Toronto Power Generating Station, marking a significant private sector investment of over \$200 million. The restoration aims to preserve the National Historic Site while creating a world-class visitor experience overlooking the Canadian Horseshoe



Falls. Pearle Hospitality's track record in heritage property restoration, such as the Elora Mill Hotel and Spa, ensures meticulous attention to detail. A Letter of Intent has been signed, initiating a 120-day due diligence phase. The project aligns with Niagara Parks' strategic goals and will include public access areas, a museum, an art gallery, boutique accommodation, and more. The redevelopment, guided by regulatory frameworks, promises to enhance Niagara Falls' status as a global tourism destination. Pearle Hospitality envisions offering visitors a breathtaking hospitality venue befitting Canada's natural wonders.





### **GO TRAIN EXPANSION**

Ontario's government is expanding GO train services between Union Station and Niagara Falls, aiming to bolster connections for commuters and tourists alike. Premier Doug Ford highlights the benefits for both daily travellers and the tourism industry, emphasizing the role of transportation infrastructure in economic growth. Commencing on May 20, weekday trips to Niagara Falls increased by two, with one additional trip on weekends, totalling 21 roundtrips per week. The enhancement includes service to St. Catharines VIA station





### **DIGITAL MAIN STREET -DIGITAL SERVICE SQUAD**

The Digital Service Squad aided local businesses in embracing digital tools for growth. They offered free consultations, social media coaching, grant applications, webinars, and more. As consumer behaviour increasingly shifted online, small businesses had to establish a digital presence. The Squad supported physical stores in adopting digital marketing techniques. They assisted 56 businesses in Niagara Falls with \$2,500 grants, totalling \$140,000. Additionally, they hosted 5 workshops in 2023, attended by over 30 business owners, focusing on adapting businesses online.







### New Niagara Falls Economic Development Stategy

The City of Niagara Falls embarked on a comprehensive Economic Development Strategy for the years 2024-2029, approved by the Council on September 12, 2023. This strategy, developed in collaboration with Stiletto Consulting and Business Development, aims to capitalize on the city's strengths and emerging opportunities in sectors such as Tourism, Manufacturing, ICT, and Health Care.

The strategy is structured around four pillars: Diversify Economy, Retain and Grow Existing Businesses, Strengthen Ecosystem, and Expand Niagara Falls. These pillars provide a framework to guide economic activities and enhance the city's economic impact over the next five years.

To formulate the plan, extensive research was conducted, including the analysis of comparator

jurisdictions, asset mapping of local resources, economic forecasts, and stakeholder consultations. Building upon the successes of the previous Economic Development Strategy and FDI Plan, the new strategy focuses on maintaining and supporting existing businesses while attracting new commercial and industrial opportunities to stimulate job creation and economic growth.

Key trends shaping the city's economic landscape include Cluster Development, Workforce Development, Economic Diversification, and Partnership Development. The city possesses a strong foundation for economic development, with robust capabilities to support innovation and entrepreneurship.

The strategy's pillars and goals outline specific actions to achieve economic growth:

Diversify the Economy by strengthening priority sectors through business park and cluster development, modernizing tourism, and fostering innovation. Retain and Grow Existing Businesses by expanding support services for small businesses, prioritizing needs in key sectors, and facilitating connections with postsecondary partners.

Strengthen the Ecosystem by developing anchor institutions, fostering partnerships, and conducting a labour market assessment.

Expand Niagara Falls by encouraging development that supports key sectors, leveraging ongoing initiatives such as the University of Niagara Falls, Niagara Falls Innovation Hub, and the Niagara South Hospital.

Eight key initiatives are identified to maximize economic development outcomes, including the Music Strategy, Marineland Redevelopment, and the expansion of the Niagara District Airport. These initiatives will contribute to the city's economic vibrancy and ensure sustainable growth for the future.



### **NIAGARA SOUTH HOSPITAL**

In 2023, Niagara Health and Infrastructure Ontario achieved significant milestones in advancing the South Niagara Site capital project. Key events include:

On February 21, NH and IO announced EllisDon Infrastructure Healthcare (EDIH) secured a fixedprice contract of around \$3.6 billion for designing, building, financing, and maintaining the new site. This encompasses construction payments, substantial completion fees, and monthly service payments.

On July 18, Premier Doug Ford, along with Sylvia Jones and Kinga Surma, broke ground on the 1.3-millionsquare-foot hospital, marking a pivotal moment.

By October 16, EllisDon Infrastructure Healthcare initiated deep foundation work, driving steel piles into bedrock for structural support. The project commenced on October 16, 2023, and is slated for completion by February 2024.

The 12-storey building will accommodate 469 single-patient rooms, eight operating suites, 42 hemodialysis stations, and two MRI machines, providing comprehensive hospital services.

Furthermore, the South Niagara Hospital aims to be Canada's first WELL-certified hospital, prioritizing user health and well-being in its design. This fosters a positive workplace environment, aiding in the attraction and retention of top healthcare professionals.

Additionally, the hospital will incorporate an Indigenous healing space and garden, co-designed with Indigenous partners, to ensure culturally safe and welcoming environments for Indigenous Peoples.

### **BUILDING RESILIENCE** FOR A CHANGING **FUTURF**

Climate change is a pressing reality for our community, affecting our infrastructure, economy, and wellbeing. The City of Niagara Falls (City) is proactively addressing this challenge by developing a Climate Change Adaptation Implementation Plan. This plan aims to minimize the negative impacts of climate change on our local systems while seizing opportunities to increase resilience.

The development of the Adaptation Plan has been facilitated by ICLEI Canada and a core City team, with input from a diverse group including community members, organizations, City staff, and stakeholders. From February to August 2023, a dedicated Niagara Falls climate change working group provided valuable input.

The plan focuses on five key themes: Nature & Biodiversity, Infrastructure, Health & Wellbeing, Economy & Workers, and Resilient Governance. It includes actions tailored to address the community's highest-priority climate change impacts, with some actions incorporating climate change mitigation strategies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Implementation of the Adaptation Plan will span at least five years, with annual reports to the City's Senior Leadership Team and biennial



reports to City Council, ensuring accountability and progress tracking.

# ALIGNING INCENTIVES FOR ENHANCED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

In late 2023, Council was informed about the initiation of a review process for the Community Improvement Plan (CIP) incentives. This review aims to evaluate the effectiveness and relevance of current programs and ensure alignment with Niagara Region's incentives. The city currently operates five CIP programs, including Downtown, Historic Drummondville, Brownfields, Lundy's Lane, and Niagara Economic Gateway, all initiated in 2006 for 10 years.

### THE OBJECTIVES OF THE REVIEW ARE TO:

Assess program effectiveness, including application rates, approved projects, and economic impact.

Compare eligibility requirements, application processes, and evaluation criteria with Regional incentives.

Evaluate funding options and incentives from Regional programs to maximize funding potential.

Consult with stakeholders, such as BIAs, internal staff, agencies, and the development community.

Coordinate with Niagara Region to align initiatives.

The review, spanning 2024, will involve consultations with key stakeholders, including BIAs, internal staff, and affected agencies.



### **\* ZONING UPDATE**

### OFFICIAL PLAN AND ZONING **BY-LAW AMENDMENTS**

CBill 23 has amended the Planning Act to permit two Additional Dwelling Units (ADUs) on parcels of urban residential land containing a detached, semi-detached, or on-street townhouse dwelling for a total of three dwelling units on a lot.

Council approved a Staff-initiated Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment to align City policies with the Planning Act. With this, duplex dwellings are permitted to have ADUs. Further, one ADU on parcels of rural land containing a detached dwelling is now permitted.
